

**Preliminary Analysis of the Uncertified Partial Results
of December 15, 2005, Elections in Iraq

December 29, 2005

- (1) On December 15, 2005, national elections took place in Iraq. On December 21, 2005, uncertified partial results were published by The Independent Electoral Commission of Iraq (IECI).
- (2) The IECI is the entity commissioned to manage and supervise elections pursuant to the U.N. Security Council Resolutions Nos. 1483 and 1511. As its name indicates, the IECI is an independent body whose members were selected by a committee of international judges and legal experts attached to the United Nations. The IECI is internationally recognized, enjoys an independent legal personality with full financial and administrative autonomy. It is the IECI's prerogative to declare, execute, and promulgate rules and regulations procedures.

In summary, the IECI is fully independent of the legislative, legal, and executive branches of the State of Iraq. It is the only electoral authority in Iraq.

- (3) According to Table-1 (attached hereto), "Registered Voters" totaled 15,568,702. Approximately 70% or 10,893,413 turned out for voting, out of which there were 122,914 invalid votes and 53,994 blank. Hence, total valid votes cast was 10,716,505.
- (4) Table-2 (also attached hereto) provides a summary of total valid votes cast distributed amongst major political entities:

UIC	United Iraqi Coalition (Shia) Hakim & others

(5) As can be seen from Table-2, out of 10,716,505 valid votes cast:

- the United Iraqi Coalition (UIC) share is 4,692,672 (43.8%);
- the National Iraqi List (NIL) share is 865,615 (8.1%);
- the Tawafiq Iraqi Front (TIF) share is 1,489,327 (13.9%);
- the Hewar National Iraqi Front (HNIF) share is 411,658 (3.8%);
- the Kurdistan Gathering (KG) share is 2,209,911 (20.6%).

All other groups, individuals, and entities such as the National Iraqi Congress (Ahmed Chalabi), Hizbullah, Arab Nationalists, Islamic Coalition, Islamic Action Organization, Iraqi Tribes Alliance, Liberation & Reconciliation Gathering (Mishan al-Junori), and hundreds of others share of total votes did not exceed 1,047,322 (9.8%). This latter category embraces numerous individuals and groups none of which was successful to secure a seat in the new parliament. For example, the Iraqi National Congress (Ahmed Chalabi group) could not muster more than 27,385 votes throughout Iraq, while Mithal al-Aloosi secured 28,836 votes.

It is understood that Sunni Arabs constitute 20% of Iraq's population. However, as Table-2 shows, their votes were scattered between three major entities, namely: NIL, TIF, and HNIF, in addition to other smaller entities. On the other hand, Shia's votes were mainly given to UIC.

It is interesting to note that Hizbullah could not assemble more than a mere 3,193 in seven Shia dominated provinces as follows:

(6) As mentioned above, Ahmed Chalabi group (under an entity known as *Iraqi National Congress*) could not muster more than 27,385 votes throughout all of Iraq as follows:

Disputed Results

- (7) Sunnis plus Ayad Allawi dispute the voting outcome of three provinces, namely: Babil, Basrah, and Baghdad.

- (8) Assuming that 50% of votes for NIL (Allawi's group) and "Others" came from Sunni's and Ba'athists, and further assuming that **all** votes given to TIF and HNIF are those of Sunnis and Ba'athists (which is the case), then the distribution of votes between Shias and Sunnis of the disputed results will be as follows:
